

GRADES—Practically Level.

WATER FACILITIES

Water works system owned by private corporation. Originally built in 1881, partially rebuilt and extended 1895. Gravity system with direct pumping connections for emergency. Pumping station located at Marsh Creek, 4 miles southwest of Center Square, from which water is pumped through 8" main to reservoir of 1,000,000 gallons capacity, by 1 Laflue-Dunn-Gordon pump of 1,000,000 gallons per 24 hours. Reservoir is elevated 80' above Center Square and located as shown on key map. 17 miles of water pipes, 3' to 12" diameter, 80 single, double and triple hydrants. Pressure ranges from 20 to 60 lbs. Average daily consumption not known.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

Volunteer. 1 company, 125 members.
1 American-LaFrance triple combination, 300 gallon per minute jumper, 35 gallon chemical tank, 150' 1" chemical hose, 600' 3/4" hose. 1 Sibley steamer, 4th class steam fire engine, in reserve. 1 Boyd triple combination, 700 gallon per minute pumper, 35 gallon chemical tank, 150' 1" chemical hose, 600' 3/4" hose. 1 Cadillac service truck, carrying 400' 3/4" hose. 1 hand-drawn hook and ladder truck. 3,000' 3/4" hose in good condition.
Alarm by siren on fire house. Bell alarm on hose house.
Wood shingle roofs prohibited by Ordinance of Council. Fire Limits as shown.
